

LEGAL NOTICE

VILLAGE OF WOODRIDGE (DU PAGE, WILL AND COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Woodridge, DuPage, Will and Cook Counties, Illinois shall conduct a Public Hearing on Thursday, September 17, 2009, at 7:30 p.m., at the Woodridge Village Hall, Five Plaza Drive, Woodridge, Illinois 60517, for the following purpose: To consider four Village applications for Community Development Block Grant (CDGB) funding for the following:

Janes Avenue Neighborhood Strategy Area (NSA) Sanitary Sewer Improvements - The Janes Avenue NSA is located generally between 75th and 83rd Streets, between Woodridge Drive and Interstate 355 in the Village of Woodridge. The Village of Woodridge proposes to install improvements to the sanitary sewer system in this area.

Crabtree Creek Streambank Stabilization - The project area is located between Crabtree Avenue and Jonquil Lane, east of Westview Lane in the Village of Woodridge. The Village of Woodridge proposes to install streambank improvements to control erosion along portions of Crabtree Creek in the project area.

Janes Avenue Park Skatepark - Janes Avenue Park is located on the east side of Janes Avenue and north of 83rd Street in the Village of Woodridge. The Woodridge Park District proposes to replace the existing tennis courts with a skatepark and related improvements such as seating areas, bike racks, and landscaping.

Woodridge Community Resource Center Programming - Woodridge's Community Resource Center is located at 8274 Janes Avenue in the Village of Woodridge. The Village of Woodridge proposes to use CDBG funds to provide services and programming at the resource center such as after-school activities and English-as-a-Second Language classes.

All persons desiring to be heard in support of or in opposition to the CDBG applications or any provisions thereof, will be afforded the opportunity to do so and may submit their statements verbally or in writing or both prior to or during the public hearing on September 17, 2009.
