The Woodridge Park District and Woodridge Rotary Club's Financial Assistance Program gives residents who are experiencing financial hardships access to recreation, health and wellness opportunities at a reduced cost or with a payment plan.

Residents requesting assistance fill out the Financial Assistance application, which is available online and at Park District facilities, and submit the form along with other requested forms such as a Free or Reduced Fee School Lunch Program Letter to validate the financial need. Park District staff reviews the applications and works with the families to register for the program and apply the approved financial assistance towards their registration.
