The Woodridge Park District and Woodridge Rotary Club's Financial Assistance Program provides residents facing financial hardships with access to recreation, health, and wellness opportunities at a reduced cost or through a payment plan.

Residents seeking assistance must complete the Financial Assistance application, available online and at Park District facilities, and submit it along with supporting documents, such as a Free or Reduced Fee School Lunch Program letter, to validate their financial need. Park District staff will review the applications and work with families to register for programs, applying the approved financial assistance to their registration.
